## **RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO DISBURSEMENT OF DOG LICENSE FUND SURPLUS FROM MANITOWOC COUNTY TO THE TOWN OF COOPERSTOWN**

WHEREAS, the county clerk is responsible for administering the dog license fund and the proceeds from the dog license tax are deposited with the county treasurer; and

**WHEREAS**, if the county does not designate a pound for stray animals, it is required to return any surplus in the dog license fund that is in excess of \$1,000 to the municipalities in proportion to their contribution to the fund; and

WHEREAS, Manitowoc County has not designated a pound for stray animals; and

WHEREAS, Manitowoc County wishes to cooperate with any municipality which enters into an agreement with a humane society or other organization designated to act as their municipal pound; and

WHEREAS, that a municipality may prior to the end of a license year, by written request, that the county treasurer pay that portion of the dog license fund surplus that may become due to the municipality for that license year to the municipality; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Town of Cooperstown will enter into an agreement with a humane society or other organization designated to act as its municipal pound prior to December 31, 2010; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Town of Cooperstown is hereby requesting that the Manitowoc County Treasurer remit on an annual basis, proportionately any of its share of the dog license funds surplus to the Town of Cooperstown.
