RESOLUTION TO RECOMMEND REPEALING THE 10% MANDATE OF RENEWABLE ENERGY BY THE STATE OF WISCONSIN (Senate Bill 185 and 2005 Act 141)

Whereas, the 10% mandate creates a unneeded burden on power companies to buy or produce expensive energy, passing on the expense to the consumer, and

Whereas, higher energy costs makes it harder for Wisconsin companies to compete with companies from other states, and

Whereas, taxpayers have to pay more to cover the subsidies the renewable programs receive, and

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin has an excess capacity to produce energy,

Therefore, the Town Board of Cooperstown requests that our Governor, Representatives, Senators, repeal the State 10% renewable energy mandate as soon as possible.
