Resolution Appointing Emergency Management Officer

The Town Board of the Town of Cooperstown, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders as follows:

Whereas, health emergency pursuant to s. 323.14(4), Wis, Stat., can occur at any time and any place, and

Whereas, it is not always possible to convene the entire Town Board, and,


Whereas, it is imperative that the property and well-being of our residents be protected and,

Whereas, the Cooperstown Town Board desires to determine a procedure to declare a state of emergency,

Therefore, be it resolved, that in the event of health emergency, and the Cooperstown Town Board cannot be convened, the chairman may declare a state of emergency, the ability to order temporary closures of town facilities, and other necessary actions to protect the public health, during the emergency, and in the absence of the chairman, a supervisor may declare a state of emergency for the Town of Cooperstown, and

Be it further resolved, this state of emergency shall be in effect, until which time the Cooperstown Town Board shall convene to extend or terminate the state of emergency.
