The 2021 Manitowoc County Hazardous Waste Clean Sweep programs will be held **Saturday**, **May 15** for households and Friday, May 14 for farms and qualifying businesses.

Accepted items include pesticides, cleaning products, oil and lead based paints, automotive chemicals and mercury. Many of these common items are hazardous when used, stored or disposed of improperly. Look for items that contain the following warnings on their labels: **Danger**, **Warning**, **Caution**, **Poison**, **Combustible**, **Flammable**, **Corrosive**, and **Toxic**. <u>Latex paints</u> will NOT be accepted at Clean Sweep.

Residents and farms can dispose of hazardous chemicals for free. Qualifying businesses may be eligible for subsidized disposal rates. Businesses and farms must pre-register by calling 683-4333 by May 7.
